Welcome to Te Tira Hoe Waka 2024. The Tira Hoe Waka committee look forward to seeing you all in January 2024. In order to have a good Tira enjoyed by all, here are some of the decisions made.

NUMBERS: There will be a limit of 130 registrations on the Awa.

PRIORITY will be given to 12-year old's who are first timers along with their adult caregiver.

Then those who are committed to the whole Tira from Ngapuwaiwaha to Putiki.

Thereafter, a mixture of first timers or those who are experienced participants on the Tira will make Tira 2024. It is highly recommended that you also have a Roadie to support you when you come off the awa.

NOTE: Some marae have asked that we test for COVID, and out of respect for these marae please be prepared to be tested.

NOTE: Alcohol and Drugs are strictly prohibited while participating on Te Tira Hoe Waka.

REGISTRATIONS: Registrations will open on 1st Nov 2023 and close on 10th Dec 2023.

WAKA :

Six-man Canadian waka are the approved craft for this Tira Hoe Waka.

All other craft must gain the approval of the Tira Committee

Life jackets must be worn at all times on the WAKA and in the WATER (BYO or these will be provided by Waka Owners.

HOE (paddles) are also provided by Waka Owners

ALL Rangatahi aged 12-17 years (inclusive) must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver 18 years and over. The ragatahi-caregiver ratio is 1:1. Caregivers need to take responsibility of their rangatahi at all times, both on and off the Awa.
