MARCH PASS

A TOTAL OF 5 POINTS FOR UNIFORMITY

Uniformity will include but not limited to dress attire of all marching participants

A TOTAL OF 5 POINTS FOR MARAE BANNER/FLAG

Marae must have a marae banner/flag that identifies themselves

A TOTAL OF 5 POINTS FOR THE USE OF OTHER PROPS

Can include anything to enhance the presence of the marae to include but is not limited to the elements, the environment and what your kāinga is well known for.

A TOTAL OF 5 POINTS FOR CREATIVITY

May include marching in time, chanting, dancing etc.

JUDGING OF THE MARCH PASS

- Judges will be allocated by Nga Tangata Tiaki o Whanganui
- Each judge will use a scaling points system:
 - 1 point is low
 - 3 points is average
 - 5 points is high

**Note that these points will not be awarded against overall aggregate points*

TAONGA PRESENTATION

Each marae will receive a tohu to acknowledge their participation. There will be one taonga presented to the overall winner at the conclusion of the event (see pic). This will be decided by overall tally of points.

Te Hirau Ranga I te Tira: *"Hīrau is a term traditionally used to denote a hoe, while 'ranga i te tira' is an insightful play on the word rangatira. It also evokes the concept of 'ranga', to weave or unite. Tira takes on further depth within the context of the Tira Hoe Waka, as it navigates the river, passing by the diverse pā kāinga along its path. These places will be thoughtfully and symbolically represented in the Awa Games, each one reflecting its unique and enduring significance."*

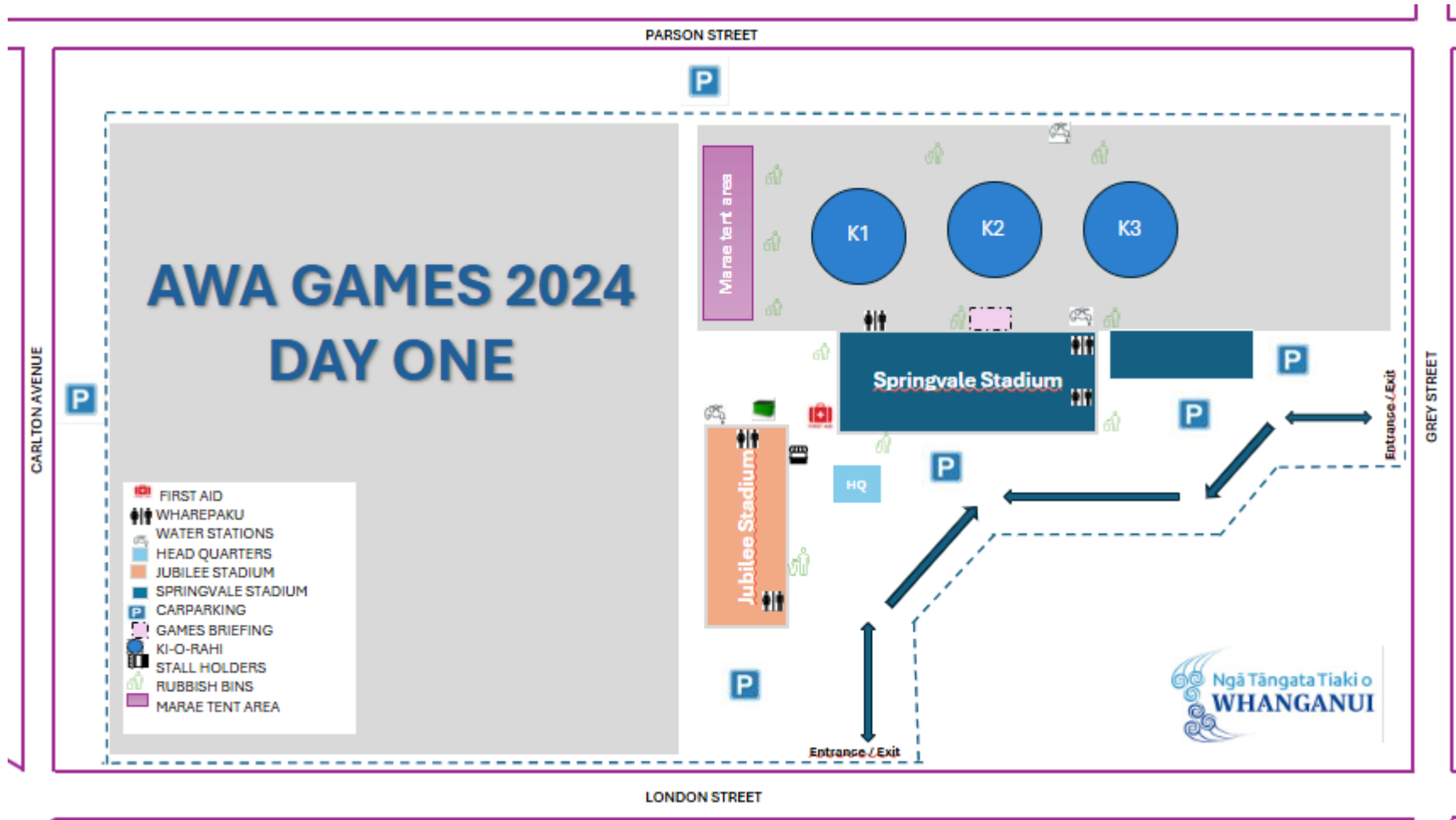
